The Emerging Scholars Interdisciplinary Network (**ESIN**) is hosting its 3rd annual Empirical Summer Program in Applied Multi-Ethnic Research (ESPAMR), 6/23-7/18, 2008, at the **University of Michigan**. The 4-week program aims to provide advanced statistical and methodological training for junior investigators and early career faculty committed to conducting research on issues affecting people of color.

ESPAMR is sponsored in conjunction with the Inter-University Consortium for Political and Social Research (ICPSR) and the Center for Statistical Consultation and Research (CSCAR). Participation in the program is based upon a competitive selection process; junior researchers and early career faculty may apply as individuals or as members of an ESIN-sponsored Study Group. To offset the costs associated with program attendance, 15-16 participants will receive stipends of up to \$2,500 dollars.
